From The Desk of Dr. Marinis

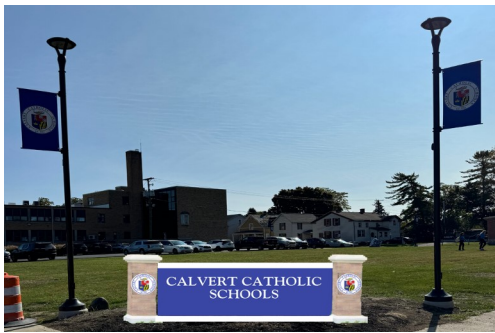
Greetings Seneca Nation,

With gratitude I write this note as we enter the Christmas season. Calvert had a blessed fall semester, from academic growth, spiritual enhancements, physical plant beautification and extracurricular successes. We are fortunate to have dedicated faculty who have embraced the vocation of spiritual formation, academic growth and student leadership. We have worked in partnership with a number of our faculty to provide them financial support for continuing education that will strengthen their content delivery in the classroom.

Calvert continues to offer a college preparatory educational path through delivering more than 14 college courses on our campus, in collaboration with multiple local colleges and universities. In preparation for the 2025-2026 academic year, the high school has plans to add three AP courses: English, Calculus and Biology. This demonstrates our continued commitment to grow academic excellence and rigor at CCS. Additionally, the elementary campus continues to flourish with a variety of student clubs, such as the Bird and Lego club. Our expanded curriculum has added our greenhouse which grows produce for our cafeteria and our enrichment students create a quarterly school newspaper.
