

From The Desk of Dr. Marinis

Greetings Seneca Nation,

With gratitude I write this note as we enter the Christmas season. Calvert had a blessed fall semester, from academic growth, spiritual enhancements, physical plant beautification and extracurricular successes. We are fortunate to have dedicated faculty who have embraced the vocation of spiritual formation, academic growth and student leadership. We have worked in partnership with a number of our faculty to provide them financial support for continuing education that will strengthen their content delivery in the classroom.

Calvert continues to offer a college preparatory educational path through delivering more than 14 college courses on our campus, in collaboration with multiple local colleges and universities. In preparation for the 2025-2026 academic year, the high school has plans to add three AP courses: English, Calculus and Biology. This demonstrates our continued commitment to grow academic excellence and rigor at CCS. Additionally, the elementary campus continues to flourish with a variety of student clubs, such as the Bird and Lego club. Our expanded curriculum has added our greenhouse which grows produce for our cafeteria and our enrichment students create a quarterly school newspaper. These experiential opportunities provide for student growth both inside and outside of the classroom.



There have been many beautification upgrades at the academy and high school campus. We started by installing light posts that also hang school flags illustrating our academic crest. These have improved safety aspects of our campus, while providing a professional appearance. We have created a memory garden and freshly painted the Calvert letters that appear on the Jefferson Street facing side of the building. We are in the process of installing a sign at the corner of Jefferson and Madison Street during the spring semester as seen here.

All of these projects are made possible through your generous support, and for that we thank you.

We continue to have great success with our extracurricular programs. The music department is thriving with growth in student participation that has created amazing energy and excitement at various athletic events. It is a wonderful demonstration of our students' support for one another. We were blessed to have a number of sports programs compete at the state level under the direction of outstanding coaches. Calvert is fortunate to have mentors lead programs and be focused on student development and leadership.

In closing, we continue to attend Mass weekly in church as a Calvert community. While this is not the easy approach to worship, walking to St. Joseph, it is the correct approach. The spiritual formation is the foundation of our Catholic school as we grow our Theology Department under the direction of *Mr. Kory Wise '15*.
